Mansfield District Council are responsible for the maintenance of 3 closed churchyards within the District namely: -

- St Edmund's Churchyard Extension, Welbeck Road, Mansfield Woodhouse
- St Peter & St Paul's Closed Churchyard, Church Street, Mansfield
- St Alban's Closed Churchyard, Forest Town (please note this does not include the churchyard extension to the rear which is still open for burials).

The transfer is compulsory, not dependent on the condition of the churchyard in question, and not dependent on the local authority's ability to meet the additional maintenance costs. The Church of England still retains a significant control over the management of the site.
